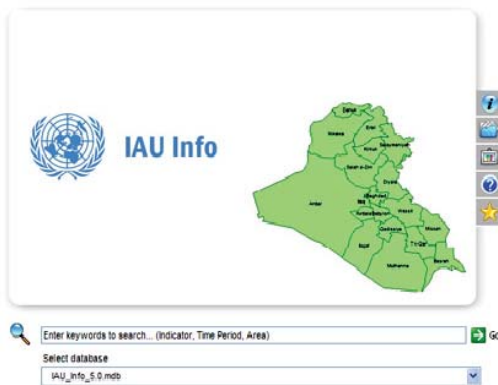

The Calendar (<https://calendar.ochairaq.org>) contains details of General and Sector-specific meetings and events. Sector coordination staff should add events.

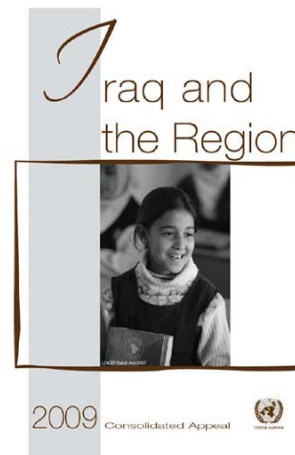
