



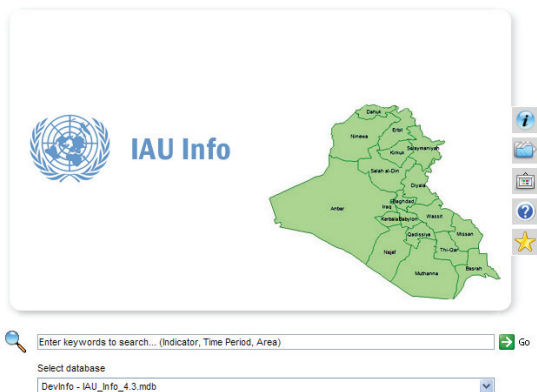

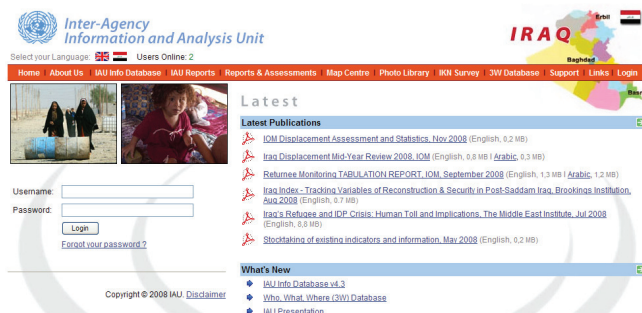
IAU Info v4.3 Database

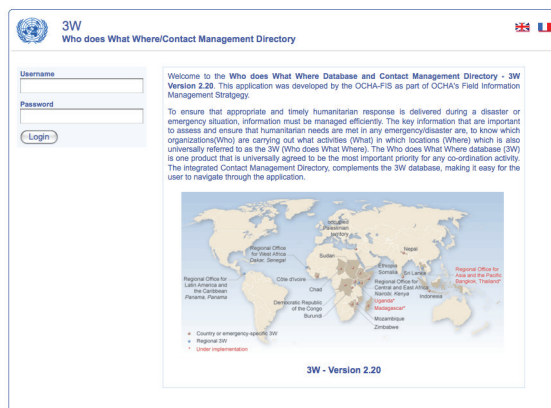

Emergency Info

Building on the sector matrices developed earlier this year in response to the Sadr City and Basra emergencies, the IAU is developing a web-based system to address the need for a tool to compile information and coordinate emergency response activities. The system will allow 24/7 online updates, rapid reports and flexible information display by sector, location and type of incident.



Report on Soaring Food Prices

The August IAU report will be updated with new information on food prices and household nutritional status, and will be made available later this month.

UN Web Portal

In an effort to coordinate information from the different agencies, the IAU is developing a one-stop web portal that directs you to the IAU, OCHA and UNAMI websites and databases including the ITF, DAD, IAU Info, 3W and EmergencyInfo.
