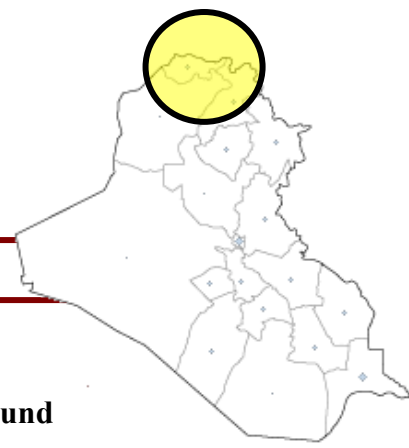

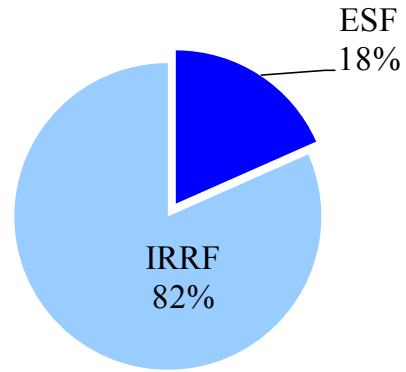

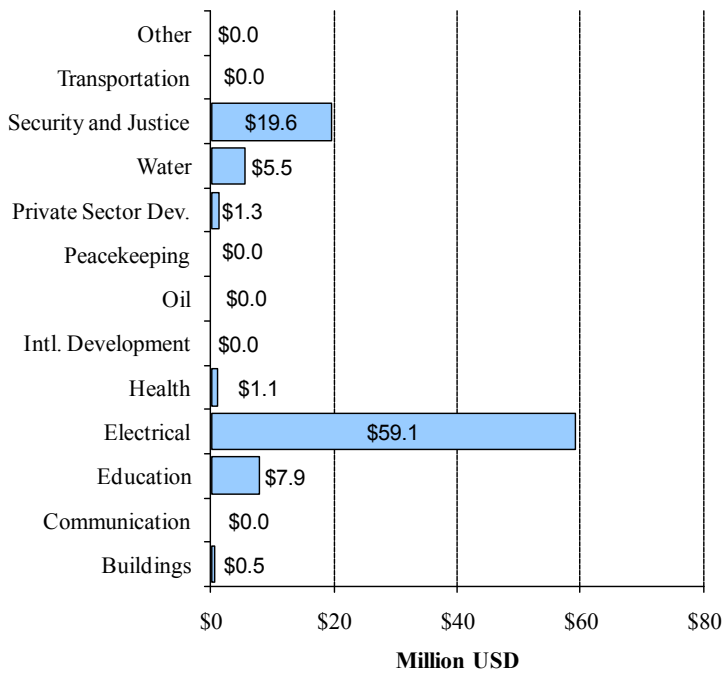

IRRF Spending By Sector (\$ mil.)



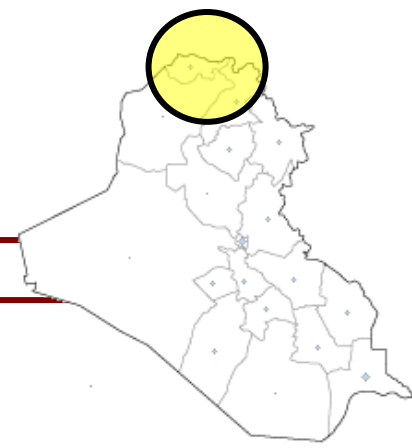

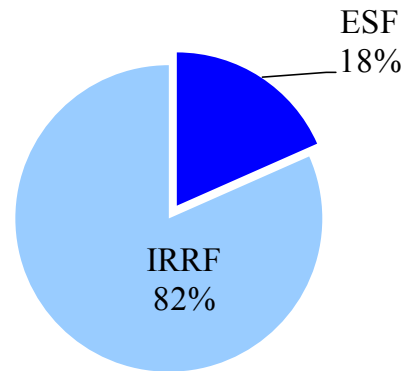
Dahuk Funding Overview: Department of State Funds



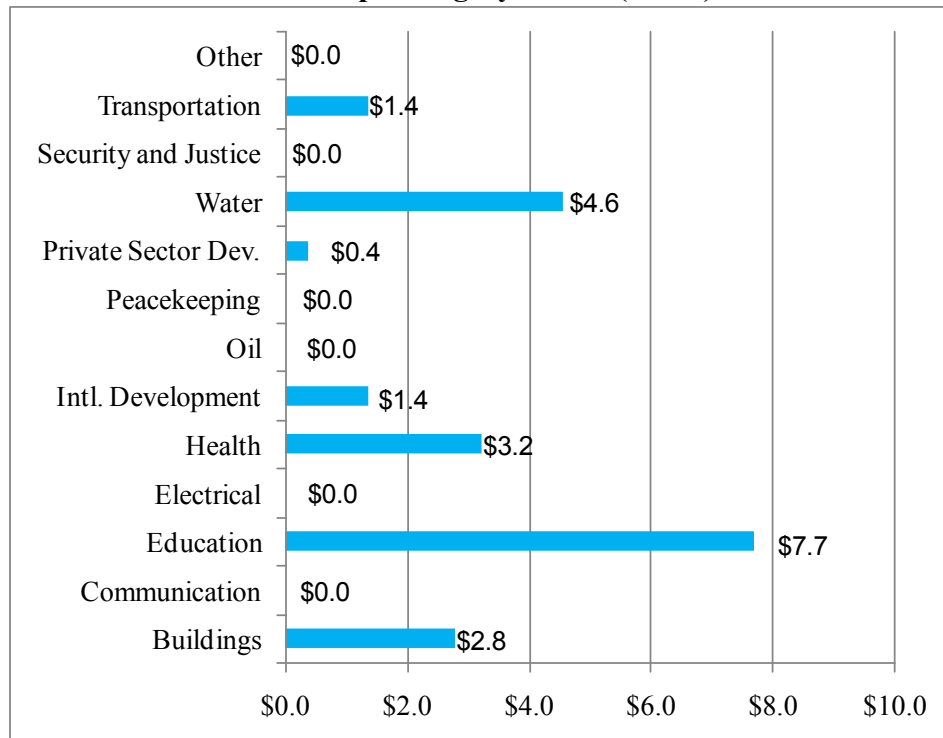

Spending By Fund



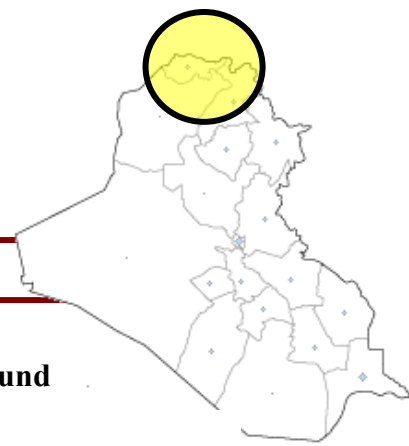
ESF Spending By Sector (\$ mil.)

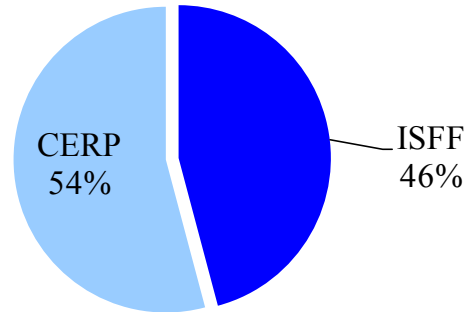

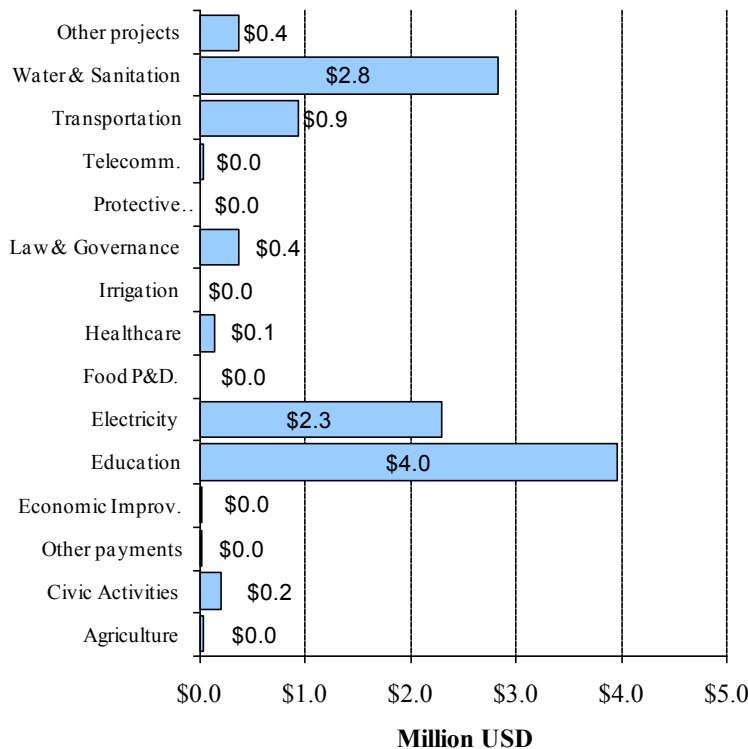

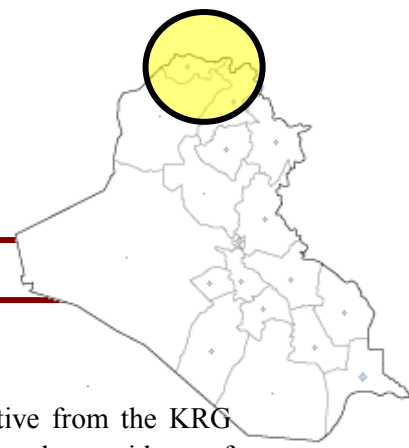

PRT & PRDC ACTIVITIES

PRT Highlights

- The RRT's RTI Advisor for Economic Development along with a representative from the KRG Ministry of Planning (MOP) met recently with Dahuk Province's Vice-Governor, the presidents of the Dahuk Chamber of Commerce, the Contractors Union, the Businessmen Union and the Industrial Union, as well as the Dean of Economics and Business from the University of Dahuk and representatives from other business-related institutions. An additional meeting was also held with a member of the Board of Directors from the Erbil Chamber of Commerce and Industry. At the end of each visit Memorandums of Understandings were signed between the MOP and representatives from the unions and business institutions with each party agreeing to work together toward achieving the necessary reforms.

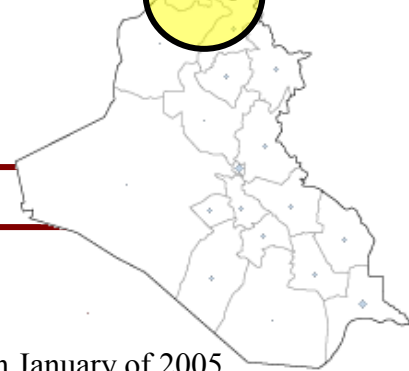


COMPLETED PROJECTS

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- Construction on the IRRF-funded **Zahko Military Academy** completed in January of 2005. Work included renovation of the Headquarters and training buildings and two dining facilities, construction of two new CMU HQ and barracks buildings, security walls, upgrades to the water and sewer systems; and repairs to an existing submersible pump.
- The **Military Base - IA 104TH BN** ISFF-funded project involved constructing barracks, administration/shower/latrine buildings, installing water tank and distribution piping, two underground septic tanks, generator/transformer, ten guard towers, chain link fencing; renovating a mess hall, constructing a new football field, renovating a helicopter landing zone, and constructing shelter for six cars.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- The **Zeryland 12 Classroom Secondary School** is an ESF funded project that was started in May 2008 and is scheduled for completion in June 2009. The project involves construction of a new two-story, 12 classroom school with a library, toilet facilities, guardrooms, workshop, sport room, engine generator room, and playgrounds for basketball and volleyball on a 95 X 65 meter plot of land.
