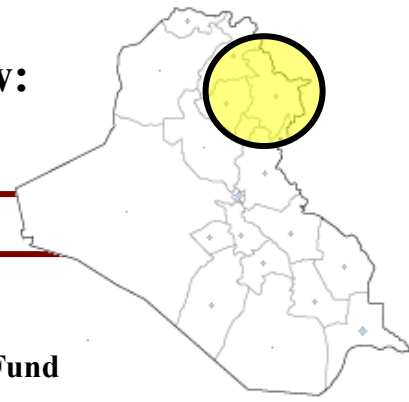

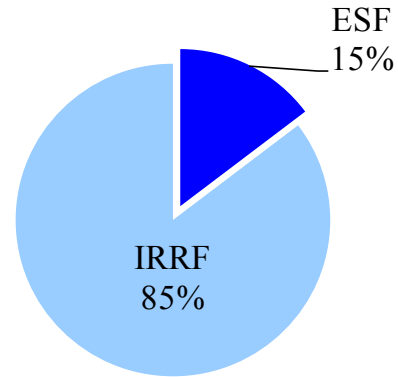

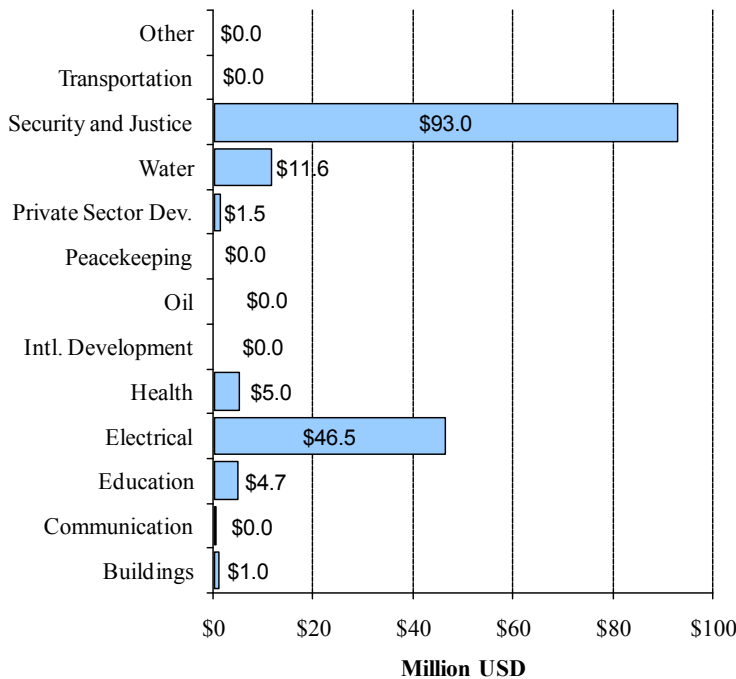

IRRF Spending By Sector (\$ mil.)



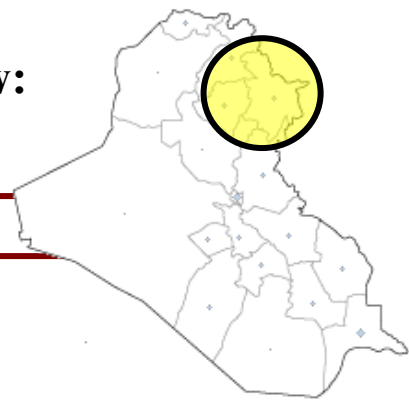

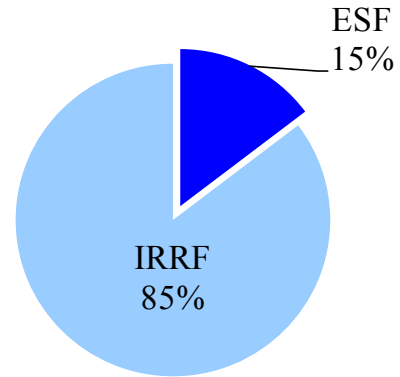


Sulaymaniyah Funding Overview: Department of State Funds

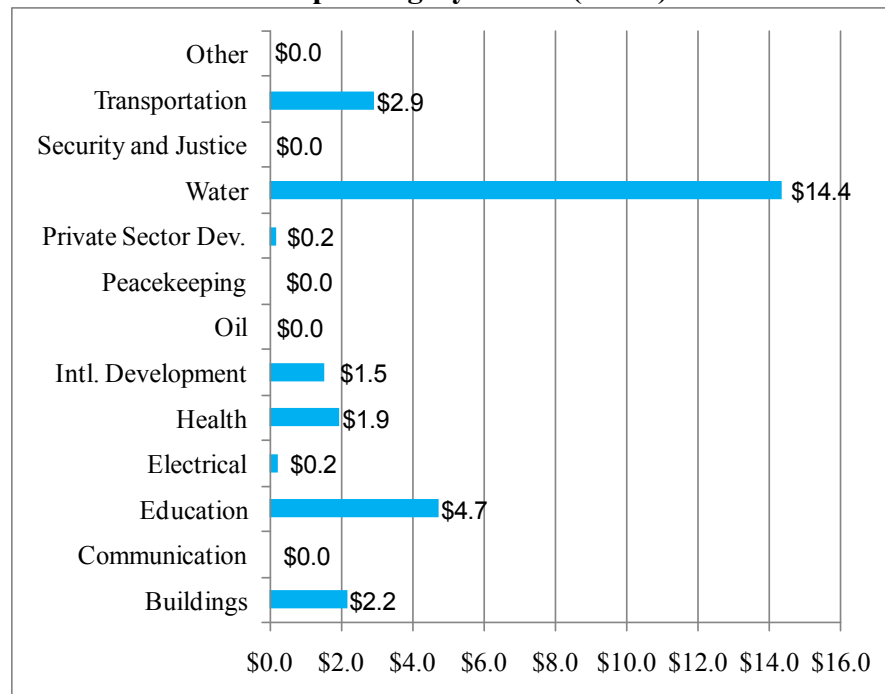

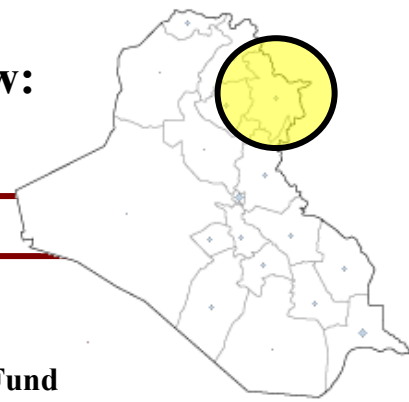
ESF Spending By Sector (\$ mil.)

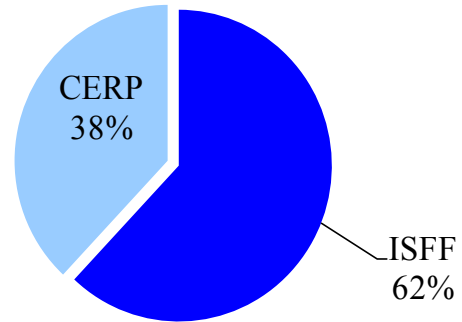

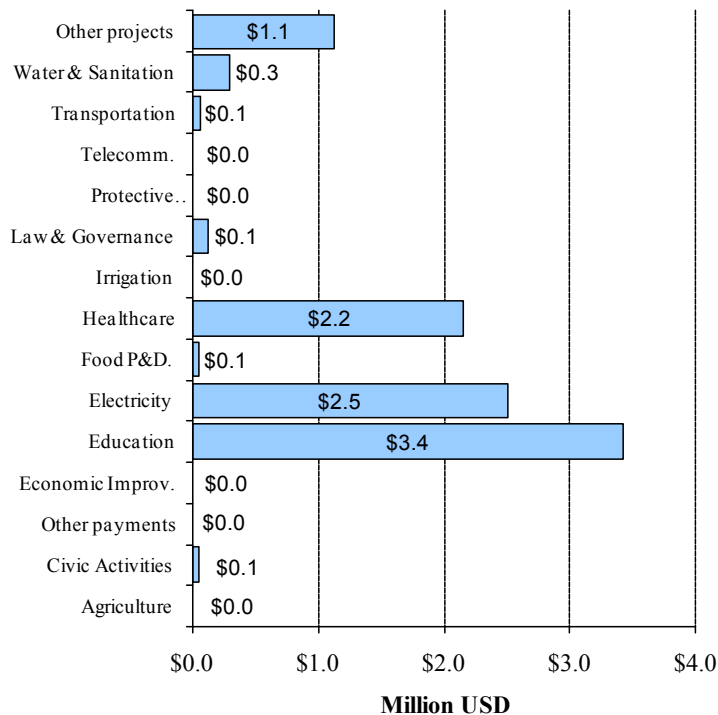

Military Spending By Sector-CERP- (\$ mil.)



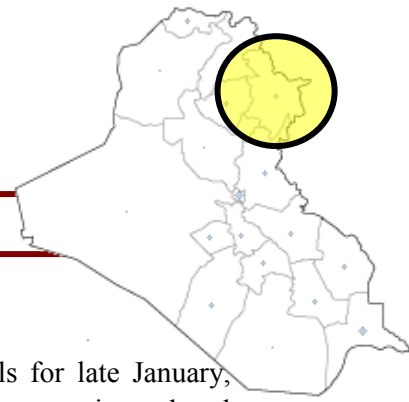

PRT & PRDC ACTIVITIES

PRT Highlights

- The PRT PD section scheduled a workshop for NGOs on preparing proposals for late January, hosted a roundtable with five local journalists, and met with officials to discuss preserving cultural heritage and promoting environmental awareness among students.
- The PRT's Economics team promoted private investment in an amusement park, a manufacturer pre-cast housing, and tourism of historical and religious sites. The Economic Team also learned that Provincial Investment Council lacks understanding of its basic mission and the law governing it, and plans to provide guidance on how achieve its mission.
- The Infrastructure/Reconstruction team addressed the following issues: establishing map overlays of Kirkuk's infrastructure; conducting assessments of water treatment units; preparing the way-ahead for Iraqi repair (including funding) of the damaged bridge infrastructure; and developing the new IT systems for the Kirkuk Government Building (KGB).

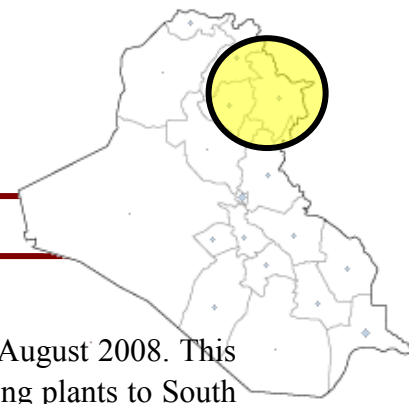

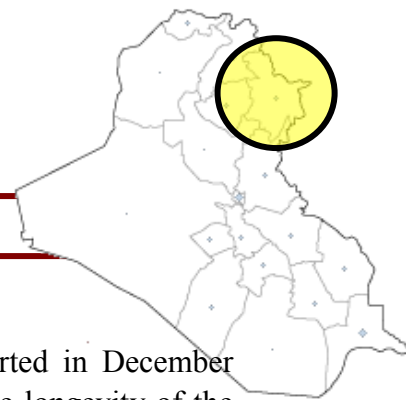
PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- **South Sulaymaniyah 132kV S/S.** The IRRF project was completed in August 2008. This substation was needed to distribute the electrical power from the generating plants to South Sulaymaniyah. It also acts as a switching station to transfer the power to other locations. The project's main objective is to eliminate power cuts and outages affecting the residential, commercial, and industrial areas near this location.
- **Industrial Region New SS.** The IRRF project was completed in March 2006 and is designed to improve the overall power factor and system reliability of the electrical system.
- **PW-062 Design Dukan-Suleimaniyah, Chamchamal Water Supply System.** The IRRF funded project was completed in August 2005. The objective of this project was to fulfill a portion of the immediate potable water facility needs of the City of Sulaymaniyah and surrounding area.

IN PROGRESS PROJECTS

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- Dokan-Sulaymaniyah Water Network.** The ESF funded project started in December 2008 and is progressing ahead of schedule. The project will increase the longevity of the infrastructure and improve sustainability of the operational system. It addresses the sustainability of the three intakes for the Dokan water project to the City of Sulaymaniyah. The end state is preventing infrastructure deterioration and providing safe drinking water to thousands of Sulaymaniyah residents.
- Construction of 6 Room Primary-Secondary School.** The ESF funded project started in August 2007 and is scheduled for completion in May 2009. This project will positively impact the lives of 750 children per school year.
