Introduction

Salah Al-Din province is located at the northern part of Iraq's central region. It is bordered by Sulaymaniya, Erbil, Ninawa, and Kirkuk provinces from the north, and by Ninawa and Al-Anbar provinces from the west, and by Baghdad from the south, and by Diyala and Kirkuk provinces from the east.

It was named Salah Al-Din after the Islamic Iraqi leader (Saladdin) who was born in Tikrit, and led the Islamic armies in Al-Sham in the famous battles against the invaders French (the crusades) and was able to liberate all Muslim holy sites in Al-Quds (Jerusalem).

The area of the province is about (24.075) km² and its climate ranges between dry and semi-dry. The province is fed by the great eternal Tigris River which flows from north to south, and by Al-Edhem River. There're also two lakes Al-Thirthar and Al-Edhem. A large collection of crops is cultivated in the province and the province depends on underground waters for irrigation in some parts.

The province is also rich in natural resources like oil, gas, sulphur, salt (sodium chloride). Also many industrial facilities is located in the province like oil refineries, chemical fertilizer factory, vegetable oils, medicine factory, and electricity generation stations.

The location of province in the middle of Iraq has made it a bridge connects the north of the country with the south and embodies the natural unity of Iraq.

Administratively, the Province comprises 8 districts and it has a population of more than (1,100,000) people which forms a wide spectrum of ethnic and religious constituents, the Arabs, Kurds, Turkoman, and Moslems Christians, and all other sincere citizens.

Tikrit University represents a lively milestone posing a good image of Iraq's unity and the fraternal solidarity among its citizens. The province also commemorates the Islamic and Arabic history by hugging the holy shrines of revered Imams descending from family of Prophet Muhammed (peace be upon him). In addition to that many symbols and relics dating back to the Abbasi state are still standing. Evidences of early human civilizations (Ashor) can still be witnessed.

The provincial council is made up of 41 members representing all the people in the province. They've been allocated their seats through election. The strategic planning authority emerged from this council and it its main task was to set up a short, medium, and long term plan for the province. It comprises of DGs, CSOs, and University professors. Throughout a one year long period, SP authority held many meetings on weekly and bimonthly basis. During these meetings all collected date were compiled

and classified. Then SWOT analysis was conducted to identify strength and weakness points, and assess community needs. The Sep. 8 – 12 conference represented a final step in formulating the PDS document of SAD province.

The strategic planning authority is made up of eight sectoral committees, all technically supported by an advisory committee comprising specialists and university professors, as elaborated below:

1. Service committee; which comprises the following sectors:
 - Municipalities, urban planning, water, sewage, electricity, communications, public and private transport).
2. Agriculture and Irrigation committee; which comprise agriculture and irrigation sectors only.
3. Health and environment committee; which comprises health and environment sectors
4. Housing and Construction committee; which comprises the following sectors:
 - Housing, roads and bridges, SAD constructional laboratories, Engineering construction office, Hamorabi Company
5. Education and higher education committee; which comprises education and higher education sectors.
6. Economic committee; which comprises the following sectors:
 - Commercial monitoring, financial auditing, industry, and oil.
7. Security Committee; which comprises sectors related to security affairs in the province.
8. Civil Society Committee; which comprises the following sectors:
 - Youth and sports, office of labor and vocational training, endowment, special needs groups, relics, civil society organizations

Final PDS Conference

Under the slogan (planning together for a better future) the strategic planning authority held the 3rd PDS conference of the province during the period Sep. 5-12, 2007 in collaboration with the local government project team of the NC region. The conference was held at meeting hall of the provincial council building and at RTI/LGP local office building in Tikrit. The number of participants exceeded 80 and that comprised PC chairman and members, CSOs, DGs, academic researchers.

During the five day conference, detailed discussions and debates were conducted among participants in the field of plan preparation starting with problem definition, analyzing, and proposing solutions and that was the task of the community, government, institutions. After compiling all these data and identifying strength and

weakness points for each data set, obstacles and challenges were presented. Objectives which represent the ambition of community to overcome these challenges together with mechanisms to achieve them (strategies) were then identified. Having completed that part, a list of already proposed projects for the 2008 year was checked for compliance with the accredited criteria in order to make sure that each project meets the approved objectives. Some projects had to be dropped and many had to be added. A final procedure was the establishment of a project prioritization system by which each project acquired a ranking in the implementation schedule.

The following list is the major ideas that were presented throughout the conference:

1. Plan should grant great consideration for security situation, as all projects cannot be implemented if security is not guaranteed.
2. The role of private sector in enhancing national economy shall be given exceptional consideration. Studies on identifying best means to involve private sector in the economic life shall be conducted.
3. Stress the need to establish a balance between PDS and investment plan and understand the central government perspective and deal with it in the way that serves the province.
4. Finding out the possibility of benefiting from donor countries and organizations when implementing the plan.
5. The efforts of the strategic planning authority are regarded as a supporting means to the legislative authority to enable it to play its presumed role.
6. The plan adopted a balanced procedure in dealing with existing crisis taking into consideration prioritization and what has been implemented of different projects of different sectors during the previous construction campaign.
7. Strategic planning authority chose to continue dealing with central government legislations in order to ensure the sustenance of plan setting up and project implementations in a balanced form.
8. Endeavoring to provide basic services like water, electricity, roads and granting them a high priority ranking because they're the foundation of infrastructure.
9. Reaffirm the principle to benefit from tours to outside countries and learn about developments in different fields.
10. Emphasize the need to organize training courses inside and outside Iraq for personnel working in different sectors, and allocate sufficient fund to construct training and development centers inside Iraq.

11. Emphasize the need to establish a high level of coordination between state offices and research institutions, e.g. University, to achieve maximum mutual benefit for both sides and community.
12. Stress the significance of the role of media in raising community awareness and developing stronger orientation towards performance of different state offices. And work to found an official satellite channel to deal exclusively with province affairs.
13. Make sure that the PDS plan is comprehensive for all sectors so that objectives of different sectors do not intersect but sectors can overlap.
14. Emphasize the need to activate law and protect the public finance.
15. Reaffirm the appropriateness of adopting a direct implementation procedure at the current stage and provide all requirements.
16. Make sure that positions like DGs shall only be occupied by experienced and specialized people.
17. Reaffirm the significance of participation of CSOs and tribal sheikhs in assessing community needs and monitoring work progress, and the need to activate their roles in promoting the spirit of virtue in community as it represents the fifth power in society.
18. Emphasize the need to update and modernize scientific curriculums in universities in a way that pertains to the established needs in the applied fields.
19. Stress the need to provide appropriate atmosphere for teachers and university professors to enable them perform their technical tasks efficiently.
20. Endeavoring to consolidate the spirit of citizenship and dedication, public finance safeguarding, accuracy, and responsibility bearing among construction engineers.
21. Reaffirm the preparation of special paper on education and higher education affairs in the province aims to study problems of this sector and future horizons and upgrading means and identify means to clamp down on the cheating habits, and fortify society against these defects.
22. Reaffirming the spread of health and environmental culture in the society and the adoption of active mechanisms to crack down on health risks, including activation of production rate increase measures of medicine factories and anti-pollution researches.
23. Introducing new laws and legislations which aim to secure the graduation of qualified doctors, engineers, and technicians from province citizens exclusively. And that includes improving of University admission system in order to bridge the province deficit for these qualifications.
24. Show exceptional interest in the ration card system and the items of the foodstuff basket.

25. The possibility of accrediting researches and thesis of undergraduates and postgraduates of Tikrit University as solutions and remedies for problems presented by state offices and departments.
26. Endeavoring to activate cultural and literary organizations in order to consolidate and spread the culture of citizenship.
27. Reaffirm the significance and role of studying by correspondence and evening schools
28. Found scientific institutions in order to meet the current and future needs of society to advanced and middle cadre in the fields of health, engineering, science, economy, and agricultural sciences.
29. Reaffirm the principle of investment activating, and accreditation of projects associated with positive outcomes and long term in order to serve society, reduce unemployment, and provide revenues.
30. Terminate the process of handing over village clean water facilities to local villagers as it has been a practice to run these facilities by local villagers themselves. The allocated fund shall be used to hire qualified staff to operate, maintain, and guard these facilities. And also to install new compound water facilities to keep abreast with the growing number of population.

Proposed projects for public services sector

Problems:

1. Area covered by public services is very limited.
2. Existing public service projects are beginning to wear out, and town designs become old-fashioned and needs modernization.
3. Lack of technical experience
4. Decline in citizen awareness with regard to handling public services and related regulations. Also the lack of a strong executive authority has encouraged citizen to commit public property trespass.
5. Amount of revenues collected in return for delivered public service is relatively very low.

Strategies:

1. Provide comprehensive technical and engineering studies for service sector, starting from the basic sectoral design and the introduction of full services in

some way that rule out any interference when conducting different projects for this sector.

2. Update and upgrade old projects so that it complies with international standard specifications.
3. Formulating plans to train technical staff and modifying the administration structure and adopting modern practical programs.
4. Improve capacity through the use of modern equipment to keep abreast with the current improvement of specifications.
5. Raise the cultural level awareness of citizen through media.
6. Activate the laws that deal with public property trespass.
7. Enact new laws on regulating revenue collecting process, and introduce amendments to the fees of delivered services.
8. Create the suitable environment to apply privatization.

Objectives:

1. Expand the area covered by public service delivery to include villages.
2. Consolidation of cadres and capacity to reach an advanced scientific and conceptual level that can enable them to upgrade other cadres.
3. Enable public service departments to highest level of self-sufficiency in terms of revenues.
4. Raise awareness of ordinary citizen and turn him into an assisting tool in improving public service delivery.
5. Prepare a plan to throw light on SAD province and its historical and cultural inheritance by enlisting the assistance of media references and print a booklet on this, and address this issue at local and international conferences.
